- **Foals must be weaned**
- **Foals must not be shown under 20 weeks of age**
- **Foals must only be shown in a halter or head collar**
- **No foal to be shown in a bit of any type**
- **No foal to be lunged**
- **No foal to be body clipped**

Extract taken from "*The National Pony Society 2010 Showing and Competition Rules*".

This year's show will be held at The Gleneagles Equestrian Centre at Auchterarder, Perthshire and obviously if this later date is successful it will become a regular fixture in the calendar.

The Show will once again be affiliated to the Shetland Pony Society as in 2009 and we look forward to good entries on the day.

Would all exhibitors please ensure that entry forms are completed fully with all details of sire, dam, registrations numbers etc. Thank you.
