

GREER RALSTON – RALSTON FINE ART

Greer Ralston is a well known Scottish figurative and equestrian artist.

Having ridden from an early age Greer, who was a regular on the Scottish Lead Rein circuit in the late 60's with her Dartmoor pony Glenfarg Aries, returned to painting horses after the death of her late father, Gilbert Ralston, who rode and bred a number of well known Scottish showjumpers. Her appreciation of the form and nature of the horse is clearly evident in her work,

Over the years, Greer has raised many thousands of pounds for a number of charities, most notably by having portrait commissions auctioned by Christies in London. She also supports a range of equine charities and causes.

A graduate of Glasgow School of Art, her work has been exhibited in many well known galleries including the National Portrait Gallery in London.

Although her work is mainly sold through galleries, Greer and her sister Aileen have recently set up Ralston Fine Art and occasionally have a stand at equestrian events such as Blair Castle or Strathallan Horse Trials.
