GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

All exhibitors are assumed to have read these conditions and questions arising out of the Show will be determined by reference to these conditions. Questions not covered by these conditions will be decided by the Committee of NPS Scotland.

1. The Committee reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate classes in the event of insufficient entries.
2. The Committee reserve the right to split classes on the day if entries justify.
3. The Committee reserve the right to refuse an entry. Entries must include the correct fees to be accepted. No substitution or nomination entries will be accepted. **Any entries received after 12.00 noon on the closing date (23 November) will be returned as they will be due to pay £14.00 per entry (Entries on the day rate.)**
4. No exhibitor may enter and compete with an animal under a Judge who is known to have bred, sold, produced or received financial gain from that animal.
5. All stock exhibited must be the bona fide property of the Exhibitor at the date of entry and at the date of exhibition.
6. All animals must be sound. If, in the opinion of the Judge, an animal is considered to be unsound, the exhibitor will be asked to withdraw from the class. The Judge's decision is final.
7. Any animal found to be suffering from a contagious or infectious disease is to be removed from the showground immediately at the request of the Show Committee.
8. Any animal not under control is to be removed from the showground immediately at the request of the Show Committee.
9. National Pony Society rules on showing foals:
 - **Foals must be weaned**
 - **Foals must not be shown under 20 weeks of age**
 - **Foals must only be shown in a halter or head collar**
 - **No foal to be shown in a bit of any type**
 - **No foal to be lunged**
 - **No foal to be body clipped**
10. The Show Committee or any of its assistants or stewards shall in no way be responsible for any loss, injury or damage that may happen to exhibitors or their assistants or other members of the public, or to any animal or property or to any vehicle brought into the showground or leaving same.
11. Anyone conducting themselves in a disorderly manner will be asked to leave the showground. Objections shall be made in writing within thirty minutes of the event concerned and lodged with the Secretary, together with the sum of £50.00 which shall be returned if the objection is upheld.
12. It is recommended that all exhibitors have their own Public Liability insurance cover.
13. **NO refund of entry money can be claimed under any circumstances. NO substitution or nomination entries.**
14. The Judges decisions are final.

As this show is affiliated to The Shetland Pony Stud-Book Society, the following rules must be adhered to.

- 1. Classes must be confined to Registered Ponies. Ponies must be named on the entry form and in the catalogue if one is produced. Society rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or eligible for registration (i.e. foals)**
- 2. Three year old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the Show.**
- 3. Children under 14 yrs old may not show colts (excluding foals) or entire males in In-hand classes. In the interests of safety, hard hats must be worn by all handlers aged 14 yrs or under in In-hand classes.**
