RULES AND REGULATIONS

All exhibitors are assumed to have read these conditions. Questions not covered by these conditions will be decided by the Show Committee.

1. The Committee reserves the right to cancel or amalgamate classes in the event of insufficient entries.
2. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry. Entries must include the correct fees to be accepted. No substitution or nomination entries will be accepted. **NO refund of entry money can be claimed under any circumstances. Any entries received after 12.00 noon on the closing date (20 March) will be returned as they will be due to pay the 'entry fee on the day' rate.**
3. (a) An exhibitor may not knowingly exhibit a pony bred, sold, leased, produced, broken or trained by the Judge, and/or his/her immediate family or his/her employer or by anyone with who he/she resides.
(b) A rider/handler may not compete in a Class judged by someone for whom he/she has exhibited in the show ring within the previous 12 months.
(c) An exhibitor may not show under a judge for whom he or she has produced a pony within the previous 12 months. (An exhibitor is, the owner, the lessee or the person who produces and/or shows the pony.)
4. **Exhibitors are requested to note the timetable. Where an animal is entered in more than one class, the Committee can take no responsibility if a clash in time occurs.**
5. All Stallions and Colts, **TWO** years old or over, must be in possession of a current Ministry of Agriculture, NPS or appropriate Breed Society License. For Dales, Exmoor, Highland and Welsh, this rule is extended to **THREE** years old or over and for Shetland Ponies this rule is extended to **FOUR** years old or over. M&M Stallion and Colts, two years old or over, **MUST** be adequately bitted. For Riding Pony and Hunter Pony Breeding Classes, Stallions and Colts, 2 years old or over, must be suitably bitted in a snaffle type bridle. Handlers of stallions and colts in In-Hand classes must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January of the current year.
6. The Judge's decision is final.
7. Objections shall be made in writing within thirty minutes of the event concerned and lodged with the Secretary, together with the sum of £100.00 which shall be returned if the objection is upheld.
8. Correctly secured BS Skull Caps/Riding Hats Nos BS 4472, 6473, PAS015 or EN1384 must be worn by riders at all times when mounted. Handlers of ponies in In-Hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear correctly secured current British standard skull caps/riding hats.
9. All animals must be sound. If, in the opinion of the Judge, an animal is considered to be unsound, the Exhibitor will be asked to withdraw from the Class. The Judge's decision is final.
10. Any animal found to be suffering from a contagious or infectious disease is to be removed from the Showground immediately at the request of the Show Committee.
11. Any animal not under control is to be removed from the Showground immediately at the request of the Show Committee.

12. The Show Committee or any of its assistants or stewards shall be in no way responsible for any loss, injury or damage that may happen to Exhibitors or their assistants or other member of the public, or to any animal or property or to any vehicle brought into the Showground or leaving same.

13. Anyone conducting themselves in a disorderly manner will be asked to leave the Showground.

14. Mountain & Moorland Ponies: In all M&M Classes, Ridden and In Hand, ponies must be shown as recommended by their Breed Society Rules and are restricted to the height limits laid down by their appropriate Breed Societies.

15. In **ALL** M&M Ridden and WHP Classes, spurs are **NOT** allowed. There is no age limit for riders in these classes, with the exception of Stallions and Colts when riders must have attained their 11th birthday before 1st January of the current year when riding small breeds and their 14th birthday before 1st January when riding large breeds.

16. In **ALL** classes, whips/canes must not exceed an overall length of 30" (75cms). A show cane is a plain or leather covered cane. If misused, in the opinion of the judge, an exhibitor may be sent out of the ring and may also be reported to the NPS Disciplinary Committee.

17. **Where sufficient entries are forward, on the day of the Show, classes may be split by breed, age or height, as appropriate.**

NPS SCOTLAND QUALIFIERS

THE NPS SCOTLAND OPEN RIDDEN, NOVICE RIDDEN, LEAD REIN/FIRST RIDDEN, IN HAND and OPEN WHP MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND AND RIDING/HUNTER PONY IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIPS do NOT require exhibitors to be NPS Members, but they must become members of NPS Scotland to compete in the FINALS at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials. The rules for the above competitions are as follows:

1. Ponies may only qualify **once** for each NPS Scotland Competition Final.
2. All Mountain & Moorland Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective stud book. Part bred and X registered ponies and Eriskays are not eligible.
3. Qualification can go as far down the line as necessary, except the M. & M In Hand section where qualification may go to 3rd in the championship

4. For Novice classes. Ponies must wear a snaffle bridle & must not have won a 1st in an open ridden mixed M. & M. or breed class prior to Jan 1st 2010 . An open class is one for Registered Ponies that does not mention Junior, Novice, Intermediate, Lead Rein or 1st Ridden in its description. The description may or may not include the word Open
5. Entry for the Finals can only be made by sending the official card duly signed by the Judge at the time of qualifying with your entry form.
6. The OWNER must be or become a member of NPS Scotland before entering the Finals.
7. All ridden ponies must be shown off the lead rein except in the specified Lead Rein Qualifier Class.(selected Shows only)
8. M&M Lead rein ponies mares or geldings 4 yrs and over not exceeding 122cms. Dartmoor Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh A and Welsh B. Rider under 9 yrs
9. M&M First ridden ponies, mares or geldings 4 yrs and over not exceeding 128cms. Dartmoor Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh A and Welsh B. Rider under 12 yrs

EQUIFEST SHOW QUALIFIERS

This show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at the East of England Showground on 19-22 August 2010. The **two** highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify.

NPS Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 4-6th August 2010.

The highest placed pony owned by an NPS member in each class will qualify for the final. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified receives the qualification. Qualification may go no lower than 3rd place. Judges and/or stewards are requested to check membership cards prior to presenting the qualifying rosettes and cards. NPS Adult/Standard members will be required to upgrade to Adult/Showing to enter the final.

NPS/Area 25 Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member

of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve. Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.
