We are delighted to have been able to secure James for a pre NPS Scotland Championship coaching session for Ridden classes and Working Hunter Pony classes. We hope this will be well supported and a great opportunity to get some great practice on a full set of WH fences and on grass, all great preparation for the finals.

All levels of pony/horse and rider combinations will be catered for and bookings will be taken on a first come first served basis. We have not included a lead rein and first ridden section but if there was sufficient demand (3 children) for this class we would include it. Please email secretary@npsscotland.co.uk to express an interest in a Lead Rein/First Ridden lesson.

Entries can only be made via our web site using EntryMaster. If you have any particular requests, please email secretary@npsscotland.co.uk and I will do my best to meet these requests.

Lessons are for one hour and fees are as follows: -

3 people per lesson – NPS Scotland Members £30 each, Non- members £40 each.

Lessons will start at 1pm and run through to finish at 8pm on the day. If you have a specific request on a time for your lesson, please email secretary@npsscotland.co.uk immediately after making your booking for the lesson and we will do our best to accommodate.

All lessons are on a first come first served basis, so please place your entry early to avoid disappointment.

Please select the most suitable lesson for you from the options on the website which are as follows-

1. Novice Ridden (Small)
For all breeds of ponies not exceeding 14hh. Riders any age. Ideally suited to young/novice ponies and/or riders
2. Novice Ridden (Large)
For all breeds of horses and ponies exceeding 14hh. Riders any age. Ideally suited to young/novice horses or ponies and/or riders
3. Open Ridden (Small)
For all breeds of ponies not exceeding 14hh. Riders any age. Ideally suited to experienced/open/schoolmaster ponies and/or riders

4. Open Ridden (Large)
For all breeds of horses and ponies exceeding 14hh. Riders any age. Ideally suited to experienced/open/schoolmaster horses or ponies and/or riders
5. Novice Working Hunter Pony (Small)
For all breeds of ponies not exceeding 13.2hh. Riders any age. Ideally suited to young/novice ponies and/or riders. Fences to to exceed 70cm
6. Novice Working Hunter (Large)
For all breeds of horses and ponies exceeding 13.2hh. Riders any age. Ideally suited to young/novice horses or ponies and/or riders Fences not to exceed 85cm
7. Open Working Hunter Pony Ridden (Small)
For all breeds of ponies not exceeding 13hh. Riders any age. Ideally suited to experienced/open/schoolmaster ponies and/or riders
8. Open WHP (Large)
For all breeds of horses and ponies exceeding 14hh. Riders any age. Ideally suited to experienced/open/schoolmaster horses or ponies and/or riders

Once entries close we will put the entries into suitable groups. You will then receive an email with the time of your lesson and final details

Groups:

We will do our very best to group riders and ponies best suited to a lesson together as possible. However, we do reserve the right if a particular group is undersubscribed we may cancel or amalgamate groups. Please note the height of fences is only as a guide, please feel free to drop me an email with any more information that you feel is relevant to your lesson Alicia Hay on secretary@npsscotland.co.uk

DIRECTIONS: It is suggested NOT to use sat Nav. Please use the following directions.

DIRECTIONS FROM SOUTH

A9 Approx 7 miles north of Tomatin; Turn left at Fort Augustus sign onto B851. Carry on for 2.7 miles to Inverarnie. At village shop turn right onto B861. Carry on for 1 mile. Track on right, between 2 green fields. Sign saying The Arches on one side of track, and Monadhiliath on the other. Random blue bit of pie on fence post
Follow track all the way down.

DIRECTIONS FROM NORTH

A9 south. Turn right at Fort Augustus sign B852
continue as above.

FROM INVERNESS

Inverness City Bypass to Asda. Either turn off Slackbuie roundabout at side of Asda, continue for 4.5 miles. OR Turn off roundabout at Inverness Royal Academy roundabout onto B861. Continue for 4 miles. Track on left, between 2 green fields. (As above)
