RULES AND REGULATIONS

All exhibitors are assumed to have read these conditions. Questions not covered by these conditions will be decided by the Show Committee.

1. The Committee reserves the right to cancel or amalgamate classes in the event of insufficient entries. If the show is cancelled by NPS Scotland entry fees will be refunded less £5 per entry to cover administration fees.

COVID REGULATIONS & GUIDELINES Entries are accepted on the basis of complying with the current Covid Regulations as laid down by HorseScotland

Competitors from south of the border are reminded that Scottish Government guidelines may vary from those in England, Wales and Northern Ireland

Further details of how the show will run, measures competitors need to take and any restrictions will be advised to all entrants prior to the show. The following is what you need to know prior to entering:

- 1) Entries must be made by the closing date(s) online, and absolutely NO entries (or substitutions) can be made on the day
- 2) TWO adults may attend for the first horse/pony entered, and ONE more for each further horse/pony entered
- 3) All attending, whether they are owners, riders, producers or grooms must be listed prior to entry for Trace & Protect (Track & Trace south of the Border). Any changes prior to the show must be reported to the secretary
- 4) Only those entered, competing and listed on our Trace & Protect listing at the entrance to the Showground will be allowed admittance
- 6) Currently it is not permitted for any rider to ride horses/ponies from more than one stable/yard
- 7) No score sheets will be posted to view at the show but will be available on line

The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry. No substitution or nomination entries will be accepted. **NO refund of entry money can be claimed under any circumstances**

Membership will be suspended immediately if

- Cheques made payable to the NPS, NPS Scotland or an NPS Affiliated show are not honoured by the bank
- If there is any money owing to the NPS, an NPS Area or an NPS Affiliated show
- If any trophies belonging to the NPS or an NPS Area are not returned by the requested date.

A surcharge of £10 will be charged if replacement cheques have to be processed.

- 3. (a) An exhibitor may not knowingly exhibit a pony bred, sold, leased, produced, broken or trained by the Judge, and/or his/her immediate family or his/her employer or by anyone with who he/she resides.
 - (b) A rider/handler may not compete in a Class judged by someone for whom he/she has exhibited in the show ring since the 1st January of the preceding year.
 - (c) An exhibitor may not show under a judge for whom he or she has produced a pony within the 1st January of the preceding year. (An exhibitor is, the owner, the lessee or the person who produces and/or shows the pony.)
- 4. Exhibitors are requested to note the timetable. Where an animal is entered in more than one class, the Committee can take no responsibility if a clash in time occurs.
- 5. All Stallions and Colts, **TWO** years old or over, must be in possession of a current Ministry of Agriculture, NPS or appropriate Breed Society License. For Dales, Exmoor, Highland and Welsh, this rule is extended to **THREE** years old or over and for Shetland Ponies this rule is extended to **FOUR** years old or over. M&M Stallion and Colts, two years old or over, **MUST** be adequately bitted. For Riding Pony and Hunter Pony Breeding Classes, Stallions and Colts, 2 years old or over, must be suitably bitted in a snaffle type bridle. Handlers of stallions and colts in In-Hand classes must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January of the current year. **Ridden stallions MUST display a stallion bridle marker, In Hand 2 years and over are advised to display a stallion bridle marker. These are available from the NPS** office.
- 6. The Judge's decision is final.

- 7. Objections shall be made in writing within thirty minutes of the event concerned and lodged with the Secretary, together with the sum of £100.00 which shall be returned if the objection is upheld.
- 8. Correctly secured BS Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet one of the following current safety Standards/specifications MUST be worn by all riders of all ages. All PAS015; VG1; (BS)EN1384 2017; ASTM F1163 04A onwards; SNELL E2001; SNELL E2016; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards.
- 9. All animals must be sound. If, in the opinion of the Judge, an animal is considered to be unsound, the Exhibitor will be asked to withdraw from the Class. The Judge's decision is final.
- 10. Any animal found to be suffering from a contagious or infectious disease is to be removed from the Showground immediately at the request of the Show Committee.
- 11. Any animal not under control is to be removed from the Showground immediately at the request of the Show Committee.
- 12. The Show Committee or any of its assistants or stewards shall be in no way responsible for any loss, injury or damage that may happen to Exhibitors or their assistants or other member of the public, or to any animal or property or to any vehicle brought into the Showground or leaving same.
- 13. Anyone conducting themselves in a disorderly manner will be asked to leave the Showground.
- 14. Mountain & Moorland Ponies: In all M&M Classes, Ridden and In Hand, ponies must be shown as recommended by their Breed Society Rules and are restricted to the height limits laid down by their appropriate Breed Societies.
- 15.In **ALL** M&M Ridden and WHP Classes, spurs are **NOT** allowed. There is no age limit for riders in these classes, with the exception of Stallions and Colts when riders must have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January of the current year when riding small breeds and their 14th birthday before 1st January when riding large breeds.
- 16.In **ALL** classes, whips/canes must not exceed an overall length of 30" (75cms). A show cane is a plain or leather covered cane. If misused, in the opinion of the judge, an exhibitor may be sent out of the ring and may also be reported to the NPS Disciplinary Committee.
- 17. Where **sufficient** entries are forward, on the day of the Show, classes may be split by breed, age or height, as appropriate.
- 18 **Small Breeds:** Welsh Sections A & B; Shetland; Dartmoor; Exmoor **Large Breeds:** Highlands; Dales; Fell; Connemara; New Forest; Welsh Sections C & D
- 19. Prize money Collection Prize money will be forfeited if not collected on the day of competition and within 15 minutes of the last championship of that specific day

NPS SCOTLAND QUALIFIERS - 2021

Regrettably due to so many of our qualifier shows being cancelled during 2021 NPS Scotland are not running a qualifying series and Championships in 2021. This will resume for 2022. NPS Scotland will run an Open Show at Blair Castle which will be open to NPS Scotland members to enter.

EQUIFEST SHOW QUALIFIERS

This show is affiliated to Equifest Championship taking place at the East of England Showground on $19^{th} - 21^{st}$ August 2021. The **two** highest exhibits not already qualified in classes 10–13; 14 -21; 24-26; 27,28; 30-32; 43-47 will qualify.

NPS Qualifying Rounds

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in any of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register; the GSB; the AHSB; the AASB, or registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book. Part breds are not eligible unless over stamped into one of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS **Qualifying or Life** members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 3rd – 5th August 2021.

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards **MUST** be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a **Qualifying or Life** member of the

NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette, but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show 3rd – 5th August 2021.
